COST: \$40 per exhibitor, includes entry in all divisions and day pass for expo or \$25 per exhibitor for entry into one division only (i.e. OF Breyer trad./classic) and day pass for expo.

Please note that there is a fee for parking.

All entries must be received by November 1st, 2011. There will be no walk-ins accepted.

Payment may be in the form of a money order or check. There will be a charge of \$25.00 for any NSF returned checks. No shared entry fees allowed. Each exhibitor is required to pay a fee; this includes family members and proxy showers.

SET UP: Please, NO earlier than 7:00am, Saturday, November 12, 2011. Please check in at show secretary table prior to setting up. You must have a signed release form on file with your entry form and you must sign in on the exhibitors initial/sign in sheet.

PARKING: You will be required to enter through the back door. Please use loading door 7.

SHOW BEGINS AT 8:15 AM SHARP

AWARDS: Flat ribbons and/or hand-made neck ribbons will be given for 1st – 6th place. Section Champion and Reserve Champions will receive a rosette or flat double ribbon. Overall divisional champions and reserve champions will receive rosettes or medals. First and second place winners (both breed and collectability/workmanship) will also receive a NAN card.

NAMHSA: North American Model Horse Show Association rules are in effect for this member show. Each horse that is awarded a first or second place will be given a "NAN Card". This card allows the model entry to the North American Nationals in either 2012 or 2013. It is the winner's responsibility to fill this card out completely and to keep track of it. Replacement cards are not issued by either the show holder or NAMHSA for any reason. Judges are not to show in the divisions they are judging. Judges are not to judge the horses of their relatives/significant others. Judges may not judge horses they have owned within the last 6 months, nor are they to judge any horse upon which they have collaborated upon creating. Please see www.namhsa.org for a complete list of rules.

LUNCH: There will be a 45 minute lunch break around 12:00 noon. There will be several food vendors at the expo and nearby restaurants. Outside food/drinks are not allowed in the expo.

REFUNDS: Refunds will ONLY be made for extenuating circumstances and must be presented in writing no later than 2 days prior to show. There will be no refunds if you have to leave the show and are unable to complete your classes.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: Three (3) traditional, classic or stable mate/mini size models per

class and 3 per performance class. Each model may only be entered in ONE breed/halter class. All models are to be tagged by the owners PRIOR to the show. Models should be tagged with WHITE string tags approximately 1"x1.5" in size. These 'price tags' are available at Wal-Mart and other office supply stores. On one side of the tag the models BREED and GENDER must be noted. On the reverse side the model owner's three (3) initials must be noted along with the model horse's name.

When the models are placed on the show table, the tags MUST be breed/gender side up with the owner's initials facing the table in order to make the entry anonymous. The judge MAY disqualify an entry if it is initial side up.

SHOW TABLE: Each entrant will have a 4 or 8 foot table space. All of your personal property must fit on or under the table in order to keep all the doorways and aisle ways clear in case of fire or other emergency. It will also help prevent the possibility of someone tripping and injuring themselves or damaging models. Any damage that may occur is the sole responsibility of those involved. It is not the liability of the show/show holders. Please be courteous to others and do not handle other models unless permission is given by the model owner.

ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY: Electronic devices (phones, lap tops, iPods etc.) are allowed, however, please be reasonable as to the volume.

SECURITY AND LIABILITY: Security is the responsibility of each individual exhibitor. Show management, judges, volunteers and other associated parties shall not be held liable for any kind of damages or loss to persons or property.

CHILDREN: It is suggested that young children are not brought into the model show area as they often become bored and in their activity may damage personal property of others. If you must bring your child or children into the model show area please be aware that you are responsible for their behavior and that you may be asked to remove them from the model show area if they become disruptive. You will be held liable for any damage that your child or children do.

MICELLANEOUS INFO: Foul language and unsportsmanlike conduct are grounds for dismissal from the model show area with no refunds.

Please remember - Do Not handle anyone else's models for any reason without the permission of the model owner.

Please stay away from the judges while they are judging. Save your questions for between classes.

All decisions are final and are up to the individual judge.

Original finish models are not to be altered in any way. Repairs only are allowed. These models may be restored, however, it is the discretion of the judges as to whether or not the model has been restored or repaired properly. Judges may disqualify an altered model at their discretion.

Tippy models may be shown lying down on a soft cloth. If you do not want this model handled, place a 3x5 card next to it stating that the model is not to be touched. If the judge is not to handle the model, the judge may so choose not to include it in the judging.

UNCLAIMED MODELS: Models not removed from the show tables in a timely manner after a class has finished will be moved to the 'Pony Pound'. The show staff shall not be held liable for damage or loss to these models.

JUDGES: Show management reserves the right to assign any judges to any classes or divisions at any time. All NAMHSA rules will be followed in the assignment of judges and the actions of

judges. Judging is the opinion of the individual judge and personal opinions cannot be controlled or legislated by the show management.

NO PETS OR OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS OR SHOW HALL. NO SMOKING IN SHOW BUILDING.

Definition of Custom: Any original finish model that has been altered beyond simple repairs, including Sandicast, Starlite or other mass produced models. Artist resin models may not be shown in this division.

Definition of Artist Resin (AR): Any artist's personal creation sculpted in resin which is not considered "mass produced". If the artist resin has been structurally altered in any way it still shows in this division.
